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State Assessments – English Language Proficiency Washington State has adopted the WIDA English Language Development Standards Framework and will transition into using the new standards and related assessments in the 2021-22 school year. WIDA is a 40-state consortium that promotes educational equity for multilingual learners through language development standards, assessments, and high-quality professional learning for P-12 educators.			
WIDA Screener for Kindergarten and WIDA Screener	Grades K - 12	Aug. 30, 2023 – June 14, 2024	Required for newly enrolled students who first learned or actively speak a language other than English at home, as well as newly enrolled Native American students who are academically at risk. K is only offered via paper/pencil, 1-12 is online
WIDA ACCESS Annual Test Assesses language proficiency growth of Multilingual learners. • Reading • Listening • Writing • Speaking	Grades K - 12	January 29-March 21	Required annually for all qualified Multilingual Learners.
WIDA Alternative ACCESS	Grades K-12	January 29-May 3	Students with significant cognitive disabilities may participate in this assessment as an alternative to WIDA ACCESS for the purpose of meeting the annual requirement for all qualified Multilingual Learners.
